COMMANDER'S MESSAGE

Our State Convention will be in Manchester at the Radisson Hotel this year. You do not need to be a Delegate to attend the state convention. However, you are required to be a delegate to vote for next year's Department Commander and staff. Moving forward; the information that's delivered on the floor involves each of the Post, Ladies and Sons organizations.

To give you a brief overview of the weekend; the convention opens for all hands Friday morning followed by our traditional memorial service honoring all of our fallen comrades, ladies and sons in the state. After the services, the ladies and sons break-off to attend their own meetings while the delegates go to their committee meetings. For those who are unable to be in attendance at the convention, our delegates who attended will provide a report from their committee meeting at the July Post meeting.

When we return from convention the Adjutant will have the 2019 membership cards ready for issue. For those of you who joined in the past year and to remind our loyal members, the Post has a promotional renewal program called "Early Bird?" An "Early Bird" is someone who renews their membership for the following year before October 15th receives an Early Bird stamp on their membership card. To let you know why the Post promotes this program, the American Legion National Headquarters sets specific membership goals and dates for all Posts to achieve within the
