ESSAY AND SCRAP BOOK RULES

- 1) You May include any information gathered from Newspaper clippings, photos, historical, climates, food, dress, traditions, and recipes.
- 2) The first page must have the Name, and Address of the Unit Member submitting the report as well as the Unit Name and Number and Unit's location.
- 3) Scrap book cannot be larger than 12"X15" and CAN NOT exceed 50 pages. All photos, sketches, recipes and entries in the scrapbook should have a small summary of each item.
