We are writing to request your help in contacting the NH American Legion Commanders and NH veterans.

We organize an annual Sept. 11th memorial at the Cathedral of the Pines in Rindge. It is a reading of the victim's names. The recording of The Pentagon victims was read by former Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, Adm. Mike Mullen. This year is the 20th anniversary of 9/11. It falls on a Saturday.

We would like to have uniformed members of the Armed Forces to be present at the memorial to honor the memory of those who lost their lives at The Pentagon

The Cathedral is a non-denominational sanctuary. It is the home of the "Altar of the Nation." It was built in 1946 and recognized by Congress in 1957 as a National Memorial to American men and women who lost their lives in war.

I talked with Tom Wiley at your office. He mentioned that there are various ways that you may be able to let your Commanders and veterans know what we are doing and what we are requesting.

Attached please find this year's poster, brochure, timeline, and a letter from The Honorable Andrew H. Card Jr. Andy is the man who told the President that we were under attack.

Remember to Remember September 11

The recorded reading of the names of the victims of the terrorist attack against the United States on September 11, 2001, is read by actress Betsy Palmer, actor Jerry Orbach, Admiral Mike Mullen, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, at The Pentagon, Public Affairs Officer Alan Hicks at the Port Authority of New York & New Jersey (PANY&NJ) and volunteers at the New York Unit of the Recording for the Blind & Dyslexic (RFB&D). The reading of the 2,977 names takes approximately 3 hours.

Ms. Palmer read the names of the victims of Flight 11, Flight 175, Flight 77, and Flight 93. RFB&D recorded names of the victims at the World Trade Centers and the FDNY Firemen. Mr. Hicks recorded the names of the Officers from PANY&NJ. Mr. Orbach read the names of the NYPD Police Officers. Adm. Mullen read the names of The Pentagon victims.

The **Remember to Remember September 11** memorial was founded and coordinated by Artist/Poet James Pelletier. RFB&D Production Director Todd Palumbo oversaw the recordings read by Ms. Palmer, Mr. Orbach, Mr. Hicks, and the volunteers at NY-RFB&D at their studios in NYC. Adm. Mullen recorded the names at The Pentagon. The United Nations Translation and Editorial Division offered their help with the pronunciation of people's names.

Remember to Remember September 11 is an all volunteer effort.

Dear Caring Citizen:

You probably remember exactly where you were on 9/11/2001. You remember the emotions that day. The horror of planes being flown into buildings, thousands of innocent victims, citizen and first responder heroes, and so much more. We promised to REMEMBER TO REMEMBER.

On 9/11/ 2001, I was with The President at the Emma E. Booker Elementary School in Sarasota, Florida. Yes, I was the one who entered the classroom with the President sitting in front of second graders, approaching from behind, and then whispering to President George W. Bush: "...America is under attack!" That day changed our lives. We promised never to forget the 2977 victims that day, on Flights AA11, UA 175, AA77, UA 93, in the World Trade Center in NYC, or in the Pentagon.

We promised to remember the civilian heroes charging with "Let's roll" to prevent a likely strike on the US Capitol, and instead creating hallowed ground in a field in Shanksville, PA.

We promised to remember Fire Fighters, EMTs, Law Enforcement Officers, and other First Responders that died answering the call to duty. We promised NEVER TO FORGET!

Every September 11th, thousands of people around the world gather at solemn places to keep that promise. People will come together at The White House, at Ground Zero in NYC, at the Pentagon, in Shanksville, PA in capital cities across America and around the World, and at THE CATHEDRAL OF THE PINES, in RINDGE, NH, Many will hear two thousands nine hundred seventy seven names read, each followed with a single toll of a bell. Other gatherings will stand in silent reflection of the moments the planes hit or the buildings collapsed. Yes, we will keep the promise NEVER TO FORGET.

The ceremony at THE CATHEDRAL OF THE PINES will be a reverent reading of the 9/11 victims, and all terrorist victims who lost their lives on American soil.

REMEMBER TO REMEMBER. Reflect and respect by joining others at THE CATHEDRAL OF THE PINES, Rindge, NH on September 11, at 8:45 AM.
